CRMC's Grover M. Hermann Hospital in Callicoon is a 25-bed facility with 10 beds that can be used as either acute care or skilled nursing care. It is a New York State designated Rural Critical Access Hospital and offers a broad array of community health services. The Grover M. Hermann Hospital primarily serves patients within western Sullivan County as well as surrounding communities in Delaware County, New York and eastern Wayne County, Pennsylvania.

The CRMC Grover M. Hermann Hospital provides the following clinical patient care services:

- 24-hour on-site staffed Emergency Room coverage with prompt patient examination and treatment
- Medical Inpatient Hospitalization
- Swing Bed Short-Term Nursing Home patient
- Outpatient Rehabilitation and Physical Therapy

From Binghamton, NY: Take Route 17 East to Exit 87. Follow the signs through Hancock to NYS Route 97. Follow NYS Route 97 to Callicoon for 24 miles. CRMC Hermann Hospital is located on the right.
